

What is Ethical Investing?

Like most investments, ethical investments are made with a view to financial return. However, unlike most investments, ethical investments take in to consideration the effect that they may have on both social and environmental issues; examples of which include: climate change, gender equality, workers rights, arms, gambling and tobacco.



Your Guide to Ethical Investments

Ethical investments fall in to different categories so, for the purposes of this guide, we thought it would be useful to explain some of the jargon you may encounter when exploring ethical investment opportunities.

Ethical funds

Funds that incorporate positive ethical or values-based screening processes in the sourcing and supply of capital.

Sustainable & Responsible Investment (SRI)

A broad range of investment strategies that place emphasis on ethical, social and environmental good.

Environmental, Social & Governance (ESG) Investing

Strategies that take into account environmental, social and governance related risks and opportunities, commonly to help reduce risk. ESG investments are typically score-based; compiled from data and specific metrics surrounding intangible assets within enterprises.

Impact Investing

Investment approaches that deliver quantifiable benefits to society as well as financial returns.

Dark Green Investing

A rigorously screened approach to investment that avoids funding the activities of any company or industry that does not meet set ethical criteria.

Light Green Investing

A form of investing which seeks out companies that are doing good, as opposed to excluding companies that are considered to cause harm

Sustainable Investing

Sustainable investing focuses on environmental and social sustainability, to help deliver strong investment returns and address issues such as climate change.

Why Invest Ethically?

Ethical investing is a way to grow your savings without compromising your values. As with all investing, it involves risk. This is why it is advisable to seek expert advice when looking to build an ethical portfolio.

Traditional ethical investment products, such as funds, enable you to avoid investing in companies or sectors that go against your values and principles. This is known as "divestment"

As an investment approach, divestment has both weaknesses and strengths.

For example, by eliminating certain commodities from your portfolio, such as oil, there is an inherent risk that you may miss out on potential growth opportunities in the sector.

Conversely, should the price of oil fall, your portfolio is less likely to be affected.

Proponents of more modern ethical investment products, such as environmental. social and governance (ESG) investing, claim that the extra oversight afforded allows you to invest in better-managed companies. The same detailed analysis can also help you take advantage of shifts in social values, such as those surrounding climate change, by giving you greater access to growing industries and technologies like renewable energy.

Each company will have its own formula to measure ESG ratings. The following table highlights some of the most common factors often taken in to consideration.
